- Astilbes
- Companion plants - perennials
- Irises
- Daylilies
- Ornamental grasses

Flemish Sky Hosta

- 10-12” tall, 20” wide
- Blue-green wavy rippled pointed leaves.
- Blooms poke out through the leaves like a Florists’ arrangement
- Blooms attract hummingbirds!
- Slug resistant.



Ginko Craig Hosta

- 6" tall, 12" wide
- Narrow grass green leaves with crisp white margins.
- Vigorous. A good plant for ground cover, edging, accent plantings & containers.
- Adjacent plants mesh, leaving no room or light for weeds



Blue Angel Hosta

- 32" high, 70" wide
- Holds blue green color very well on huge leaves.
- Very large mound
- White flowers mid- summer
- Excellent slug resistance.



Sum & Substance Hosta

- 36" tall, 72" wide
- Chartreuse foliage is corrugated and cupped.
- Can be enormous (9' wide at maturity).
- Slug resistant.
- Sun tolerant.



Queen of Holland Astilbe

- 30” tall
- showy white flowers
- glossy bronze foliage
- late spring bloom



Hennie Graafland Astilbe

- 10-12” tall
- rose pink colored flowers
- Glossy, dark, bronze-green leaves
- Blooms in mid summer



Mainz Astilbe

- 20" tall
- dark green feathery leaves
- pink blooms
- early season bloomer



Venus Astilbe

- 30” tall, 24” wide
- Pale powdery pink flowers
- Dark green leaves
- Mid to late flowering season



Gloria Purpurea Astilbe

- 25" tall
- Dense light lavender and pink plumes
- Blooms July/August



Baptisia Australis

- Plants form a tall bushy clump of grey green foliage with tall spikes of violet blue pea-like flowers.
- Full Sun.
- 36" high & wide.



Ligularia Othello

- Clump forming perennial with large toothed green leaves.
- Yellow orange daisy like flowers 2-4" across.
- Shade.
- Moist soil.



Petasites Giganteum

Giant Japanese Butterbur

- Up to 5 feet high with 3-foot-wide leaves resembling rhubarb.
- Sun to part shade.
- Moist to wet soil but will grow in an average garden.
- The flowers emerge before the leaves — think hyacinths but mutant ones with greenish blooms on naked stems.
- A bold, textural plant, it needs lots of room for best foliage effect.
- Place carefully: can spread quickly in moist locations and is difficult to control once it spreads. Can be grown in large pots or in less moist areas to restrict growth, or spreading can be controlled by sinking a heavy plastic or metal tub into the ground and placing the plant within.



Filipendula Rubra

- 4-5 'tall
- 'Cotton Candy' pink plumes in June-July.
- Spreads by rhizomes, great for naturalizing in moist meadows.
- Full sun



Liatris Kobold

- 24” tall
- clumps of grassy looking leaves bearing spikes of bright magenta-purple flowers in mid-summer.
- Full sun.
- Attracts butterflies/hummingbirds.
- Rabbit and deer resistant



Ruffled Velvet Iris

- 24-30''tall
- Velvety dark purple blooms



Ceasar's Brother Iris

- 36-42" tall
- Velvety rich purple self, yellow and white blaze with black veining.
- Blooms profusely in early summer.
- Deer resistant.
- Prefers rich, moist soil.



Sparkling Rose Iris

- 36-48” tall
- Lilac-rose flowers above blades of silver-green.
- Does well in dry and damp soils.



Percheron Iris

- 36" tall
- Beautiful large lavender blue flowers striped with dark violet.
- Mid season bloom time.
- Easy to grow.
- Prefers a rich humid soil.



Daylily - Magic Dawn

- 30” tall
- Blooms - 5” bicolor of brick red & creamy yellow
- Mid season
- Fragrant



Daylily - Stella D'Oro

- 15" tall
- Blooms - 2.75", bright yellow with mild pie crust edging.
- Blooms in early summer followed by waves of rebloom into early fall.
- Most popular daylily.



Daylily - Bright Dancer

- 38" tall
- Blooms - 5", dark red
- early season
- rebloomer



Daylily - Across the Miles

- 32" tall
- Bloom - 6", brilliant yellow
- early to mid -season



Daylily - Real Wind

- 27" tall
- Blooms - 6.5", large peachy orange with deep rose eye zone



Daylily - Radiant Greetings

- 38" tall
- Blooms - 5.5", creamy orange with red halo
- mid- season
- rebloomer.



Daylily - Siloam Pink Petite

- 22” tall
- Blooms - 3”, ruffled pink with deep pink eye zone and green throat.
- Extended midseason bloomer.
- Multiple award winner.



Daylily - New Swirls

- 30" tall
- Blooms - 4.5", double, burgundy with yellow green throat
- Mid-season



Grass - Miscanthus Morning Light

- 4-6' tall
- dense, upright, rounded fountain like clump.
- Crimson red plume flowers that change to silvery white.
- Full sun but tolerates part shade



Korean Feather Grass

Calamagrostis Brachytricha

- 5' tall
- upright, narrow, clump forming
- Bright yellow foliage in autumn
- Purple plumes
- Full sun, shade tolerant



Grass - Little Blue Stem

Schizachyrium Scoparius

- 36" tall
- pastel colors in summer
- coppery burgundy hues in fall
- drought tolerant



Grass – Shenandoah Switchgrass

Panicum virgatum 'Shenandoah'

- 36” tall
- small, neat clump
- dark purple casts on tips throughout summer changing to dark black purple foliage.
- Prefers full sun and tolerates salt spray.
- A standout in the garden
